MOBILE FILM TRAINING PROGRAM

We co- spaced in community schools in monrovia to have a space to host our program after school hours. We have three phases of programming which includes **inspace learning**, **outdoor production** to do hands on training development of student projects and a **final showcase event** for parents, community leaders and other spectators.

As a Collective, we created this **six months (26 weeks)** filmmaking educational lesson plan which focuses on enhancing and providing the necessary tools to our students to create a final film project focusing on societal issues. Our lesson plan trains students to think about community engagement, filmmaking skills / language and how to conduct team efforts to complete final visual projects.

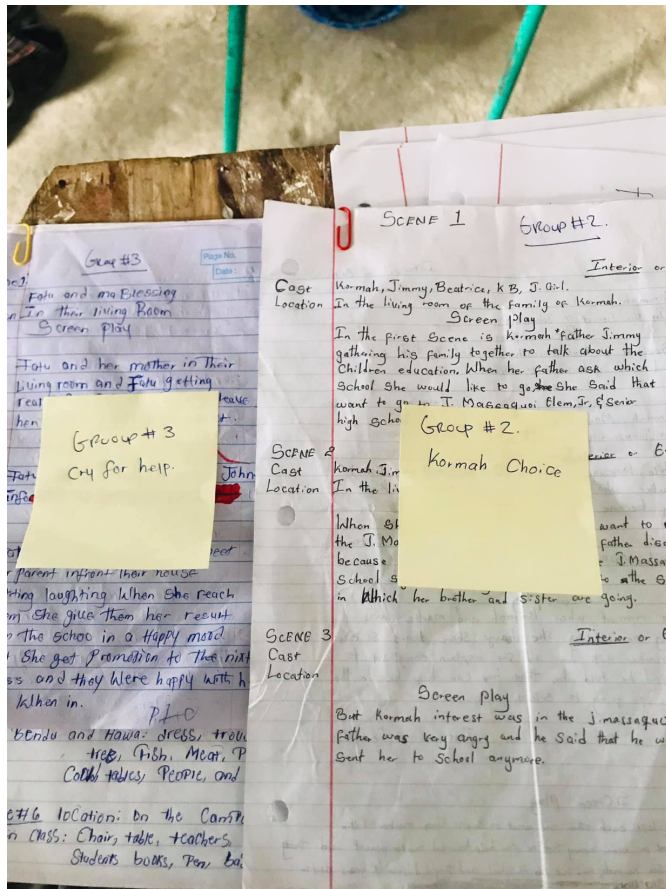

Week 1-8: Creative world school recruitment and school outreach. Once application and final selection; students will start our training sessions. Students will learn the basic steps on how to write and produce stories. Each class is led with an interactive icebreaker activity to have students become more equipped with the proper knowledge on media technology and ways they can use it to create effective film projects that can help solve SDG goals.

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS



Environment: Creative World Programs believes in a safe inclusive space for our students to create. Our Staff and mentors are trained professionals who help students explore their creativity and bring enlightenment to ideas.

Inspiration: We help develop Leadership skills, Creativity, and Critical thinking, through the collaborative and artistic process of making social issue films that highlight world challenges; that will amplify the voices of young people and citizens all around the world.

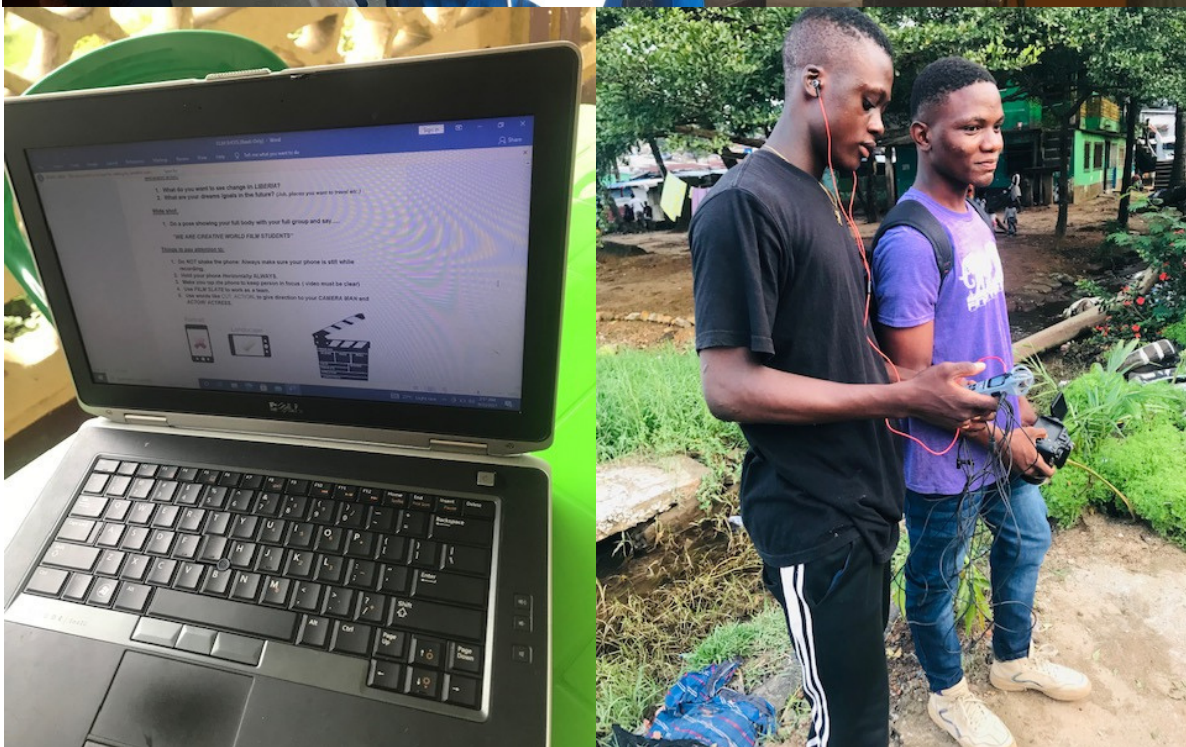
Engagement: Maximize the potential of meeting community objectives and coming up with effective Sustainable Development Goals. Our students are encouraged to use the skills in the lesson to obtain employment, earn a high school diploma or a postsecondary credential.



Week 9-14: Students will develop stories with the skills they have acquired. Storyboarding shot listing and camera operation. Students will work as a team to finish stories and find locations to film stories created. Each student will be paired with a filmmaker mentor to help guide them to complete their stories created.



Week 15-26: During this process our mentors and film students will gather for a session on completing the films created. This will require 1-on-1 mentorship. After completion, a creative world Film Festival event takes place to award and graduate all who have participated. In this process, students work on public speaking skills, writing skills and leadership.

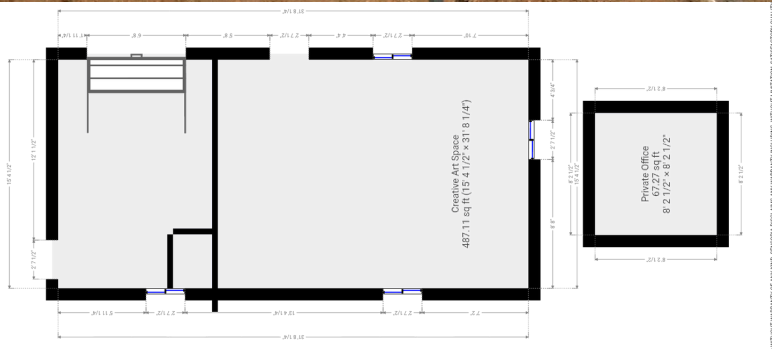

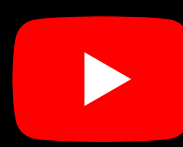

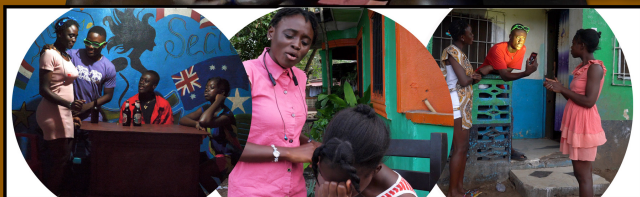
